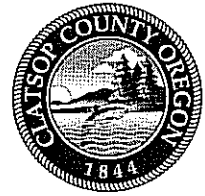

Thank you for your letter dated October 10, 2008, regarding Clatsop County's April 29, 2008 Land Use Compatibility Statement for the Bradwood Landing project (the "LUCS"), and the impact on the LUCS of a recent county referendum that invalidated Clatsop County's amendment to its OPR zone to allow pipelines in that zone as a conditional use (the "Referendum").



Because of the Referendum the LUCS is now partially incorrect, to the extent that it says the County's land use regulations allow the Bradwood Landing applicant to seek a conditional use permit to locate a natural gas transmission pipeline within the County's OPR zone.

We understand from your letter that you have not asked us to determine whether or not we have jurisdiction to regulate the actual construction of the pipeline under the applicable federal laws.
